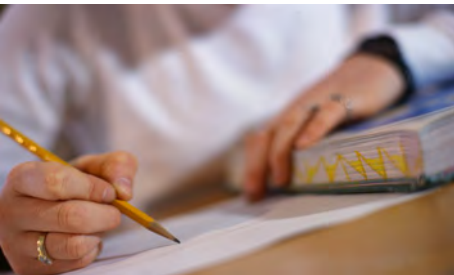


About the ATA School

ATA school is established by TAFSUS, a non-profit organization established in 1966 to promote better understanding and friendship between the Turkish and American communities through educational, cultural and social activities. In addition to TAFSUS, the University of Pennsylvania Middle East Center is a major financial contributor to ATA school.



ATA School Program

Classes are offered to children starting age 4. Learning takes place in a fun, yet structured environment where students are encouraged to work on creative projects and to socialize with each other, further developing their language skills.

Program includes:

- Language: Speaking, reading, writing, grammar
- Social studies: History, geography, government, etc.
- Culture: Art, music, theater, holiday traditions, customs, etc.

Classes meet on Sundays between 11:00 am to 2:00 pm., starting from October 2, 2011 to May 20, 2011 at Montgomery County Community College, Blue Bell, PA.
